REQUIREMENTS:

1. Duly accomplished and notarized prescribed application form
2. Four (4) copies of passport size photograph taken within the last six (6) months
3. Copy of the Original Receipt as payment of examination fee
4. Certificate of good moral character issued by the Barangay Captain where the applicant resides
5. NBI clearance/certification or Clearance from the provincial fiscal indicating he/she is not convicted by the court of any case involving moral turpitude
6. Certificate as proof he/she has skillfully embalmed at least 10 cadavers within one (1) year period under the supervision of any licensed embalmer.
7. Certificate of training of one hundred forty (140 hours) from any DOH Accredited training institution signed by the accredited training provider that he/she had received the following instructions:
